They are around \$165 now and they have been updated as far as the drives and sound quality. They do block out a lot of noise in the studio such as click, drum bleed. I will be trying out the newer version soon.



Beyerdynamic DT 770 Pro 80 ohm Closed-Back

These closed back studio headphones provide professional-quality sound for critical listening applications. Whether you're in the control room or on the recording floor, Beyerdynamic DT 770 Pro headphones are made to deliver accurate sound while providing a **very comfortable fit** a real necessity for long sessions.
